INFORMATION FOR TOURISTS

The Tourist Tax, implemented by the Municipality of Chioggia (pursuant to Town Council resolution no. 28 of 27/02/2018), has been in force since 1st April 2018.

The purpose of this tax is to fund operations in relation to tourism and promotion, maintenance and restoration work on cultural, landscape and environmental heritage sites.

WHO IS SUBJECT TO TOURIST TAX?

Non-residents in the City of Chioggia staying in one of the accommodation facilities in the municipal area, paying the tax to the operator of the facility that will issue a receipt.

HOW MUCH IS THE TAX?

The tax is due for each person and for each overnight stay up to a maximum of n. 10 (ten) consecutive nights.

You pay per person and night Hotels 2 Star € 1,80.

WHO DOESN'T NEED TO PAY IT?

- Children under 6 years (six) and over 75 (seventy five);
- Anyone who works in the accommodation facility where (s)he is staying overnight;
- Disabled people and carers;
- Anyone assisting patients admitted to healthcare facilities situated in the municipal territory (one companion per patient);
- Parents, or guardians, assisting under-18s admitted to healthcare facilities situated in the municipal territory (maximum two people per patient);
- Volunteers who offer their services in the municipality on the occasion of the events and manifestations organised by the public administration or in the event of emergencies or natural disasters,
- Members of the state and local police force and Fire Brigade who are staying overnight for duty requirements.

N.B. Anyone exonerated from paying tourist tax shall issue the accommodation facility an affidavit.
